SUBJECT: Mid-month post adjustment classification memo for April 2018

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for April 2018. Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers as compared to the previous memo ICSC-PADJ-0418-01 are listed.
2. The post adjustment multipliers based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living survey with effect from 1 April 2018 are listed in Table 1.

3. Cost-of-living survey results did not trigger a change in multiplier for **Botswana, Chile, Morocco, Namibia, Paraguay and the Republic of Korea.**

4. The gap closure measure is applicable for **Timor-Leste**. The personal transitional allowance (PTA) applicable to staff members who were at the duty station before 1 April 2018 is **3.0**. The next PTA revision is due in July 2018.

5. The waiver of the 40 per cent of rent limit on rental subsidies **is applicable** for **Guyana** effective 1 April 2018.

6. The waiver of the 40 per cent of rent limit on rental subsidies is **no longer applicable** for **Mexico and Namibia** effective 1 April 2018.

7. Based on the most recent cost-of-living survey results, the revised applicable rental subsidy thresholds effective 1 April 2018, are listed in Table 2 below.
