SUBJECT: Post adjustment classification memo for June 2019

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for June 2019. Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers are listed.

Group I Duty Stations

2. The post adjustment multipliers, applicable to group I duty stations, as a result of the operation of the 0.5 per cent rule under conditions of currency depreciation/appreciation relative to the US dollar, with effect from 1 June 2019, are given in Table 1.

3. The post adjustment multiplier based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living survey for group II duty stations with effect from 1 June 2019 is listed in Table 2.
