SUBJECT: Post adjustment classification memo for July 2020

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for July 2020. Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers are listed.

Group I duty stations

2. The post adjustment multipliers, applicable to group I duty stations, as a result of the operation of the 0.5 per cent rule under conditions of currency depreciation/appreciation relative to the US dollar, with effect from 1 July 2020, are given in Table 1.

Duty stations with ongoing Personal Transition Allowance (PTA)

10. The following duty stations have ongoing PTAs that were frozen following the implementation of special measure as described in **ICSC/CIRC/GEN/05/2020**. All staff including new staff that joined the duty station after 1 April 2020, the date the special measures came into force, are eligible for the PTA, until the special measures are discontinued. Table 7 provides a summary of the ongoing PTAs.
