SUBJECT: Mid-month Post adjustment classification memo for July 2020

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for July 2020. <u>Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers as compared to the previous memo ICSC-PADJ-0720-01, dated 30 June 2020, are listed.</u>

Group I duty stations

2. The post adjustment multipliers, applicable to group I duty stations, as a result of the operation of the 0.5 per cent rule under conditions of currency depreciation/appreciation relative to the US dollar, with effect from 1 July 2020, are given in Table 1.

Renaming of duty station

6. Please note that, in order to be consistent with other United Nations publications, the duty station Israel, Jerusalem has been renamed as Jerusalem, Jerusalem effective 14 July 2020. Accordingly, the country code for Jerusalem duty station has been changed in the XML file from ISR003 to X18001. The applicable multiplier and rental subsidy thresholds effective **1 July 2020**, are shown in Table 5.
